This month we had our drop in clinic at Longheath Gardens Community Centre, a street briefing on Gladeside and a street briefing at orchard rise .

Priorities

- Increased patrols along Woodmere avenue and Ashburton playing fields in relation to drug related ASB reports
- Patrols around the Gladeside area due to numerous reports of speeding vehicles
- Patrols around Long lane and Longheath Gardens to reduce ASB related crimes.

CRIMES REPORTED

Below is some of the crimes that have been reported for April 2024.

WOODMERE AVENUE 04/04/2024 CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Victim had front window of their house damaged by unknown suspects, damaged believed to be caused by something thrown, no further evidence was identified.

PRIMROSE LANE 11/04/2024 THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

Suspects stole victims car by hotwiring, suspects managed to hide there faces from CCTV and have so far not been identified.

TOWER VIEW 11/04/2024 THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

Victim had their vehicle stolen from the front of their property, vehicle was later found abandoned in Croydon by police and returned to owner.

SPRING LANE 13/04/2024 INTERFERENCE WITH A MOTOR VEHICLE

Victim was delivering parcels and was followed by suspects, when victim parked up suspects attempted to drill into the rear doors of vehicle but quickly left the scene when confronted.

ORCHARD RISE 29/04/2024 THEFT FROM A MOTOR VEHICLE

Suspects opened victims car door after trying the handle in the early hours of the morning, no valuables were kept in the car but contents from the glove box were scattered on the front seat.

ADVICE

With the approach of the hot weather we are seeing an increase of ASB behaviour in relation to drugs and nuisance vehicles especially mopeds and motor bikes.

When reporting please try to obtain the vehicle reg and a description where possible, it will also help if a small log was kept with times etc for those that have been experiencing repeat problems.

As always motor vehicle theft is high so please consider having CCTV or dash cams where possible, keeping keys in faraday pouches and using steering wheel locks.
