CRIMES REPORTED

Below is some of the crimes that have been reported for January 2025.

TOWER VIEW 08/01/2025 THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

Victim returned to vehicle after finishing work and noticed the front and rear licence plates had been stolen. No suspects identified.

ORCHARD RISE 20/01/2025 CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Victim noticed in the morning that the back windscreen had been smashed, believed to have been caused by a hammer, No items were stolen at the time.

GREAT GATTON CLOSE 22/01/2025 THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

Victim noticed a vehicle speed up towards their work van but thought this was a delivery vehicle, A short while later victim noticed their wallet was missing from the work van and belongings were also spread across the floor.

RIDGEMOUNT AVENUE 25/01/25 VEHICLE INTERFERENCE

Victim reported unknown suspect gained entry and searched their vehicle, nothing was stolen and no damage reported.

LONGHURST ROAD 28/01/2025 VEHICLE INTERFERENCE

Victim reported that they had a hole drilled into the back door of van, no property taken.

ADVICE

Incidents and crimes involving motor vehicles continue to be an issue for Shirley North, it most cases suspects are looking for valuables and have also been reported to visit the same area more than once, it is advised that no valuables are stored in vehicles and extra precautions are taken with work vehicles that may be housing tools.

When vehicles are kept at home consider having CCTV/Ring doorbell installed.
